**O**n Wednesday, June 16, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informational Open House for the Indiantown Road / State Road 706 Resurfacing Project, which goes from the Chasewood Plaza, just west of Center Street, to Old Dixie Highway in the town of Jupiter.

The Open House will be held from **5 p.m. until 7 p.m.**, at the **Town of Jupiter Community Center, 200 Military Trail, Jupiter, FL.** Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, construction schedule and address questions and comments.

This **2.229-mile project** will begin **Monday, June 21**, and last 355 days, weather permitting. The estimated construction cost is \$2.3 million. Work will be performed by Community Asphalt Corporation and AIM Engineering and Surveying, Inc. will oversee the project on behalf of the department.

#### **Scope of Work:**

- Repaving Indiantown Road from Chasewood Plaza to Old Dixie Highway;
- Building a double left turn from westbound Indiantown Road to southbound Military Trail;
- Traffic signal upgrades at the intersection of Indiantown Road and Military Trail;
- Sidewalk and curb ramp replacement at some locations to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards;
- Driveway replacement at some locations;
- New signs and pavement markings; and
- Minor landscaping.

#### **Maintenance of Traffic:**

In order to do this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes and sidewalks at various times and locations. Work will be done in phases to minimize impacts to residents, businesses and the motoring public.

Project-related lane closures will occur from 9:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. At least one lane on Indiantown Road will remain open in each direction and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
