Public Information Open House for Northern I-95 Corridor Improvement Projects

NORTH PALM BEACH – As part of FDOT's commitment to informing the public about construction projects, all interested are invited to attend a public information open house for the I-95 Expansion Project, 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. Wednesday, June 4, 2008.

The meeting will be held at the project Public Information Field Office at 11641 Kew Gardens Ave. Suite 101 Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33410. This will be an informal presentation. Persons attending will have an opportunity to review project plans, ask questions and express concerns to the project team.

Construction is scheduled to begin on three separate-but-related projects on S.R. 706/ Indiantown Rd. and on I-95 from PGA Blvd. to Donald Ross Rd. and Donald Ross Rd. to S.R.706/ Indiantown Rd., in Palm Beach Gardens and Jupiter, June 16, 2008.

The eight mile project on I-95 include widen of I-95 from six lanes to ten lanes, milling and resurfacing of the roadway, as well as ramps and side streets at PGA Blvd. and Military Trail, drainage improvements, noise wall construction, corridor lighting upgrades, improved signalization and signage and landscaping enhancements. The first of these projects to begin is a 1.5 mile corridor on S.R. 706/ Indiantown Rd. from the Florida Turnpike eastbound to Chasewood Plaza. This project includes milling and resurfacing of the existing roadway, signalization improvements and landscaping and pavement marking enhancements. The estimated completions of these projects are 2012.

It is FDOT's intent to maintain access as much as possible to all residents and businesses in the area during construction phases. Every effort will be made to minimize the impacts of construction to surrounding businesses, residents and motorists. The surrounding communities, residents, businesses and property owners can expect some level of noise, driving restrictions, detours and ramp closures during this construction.
