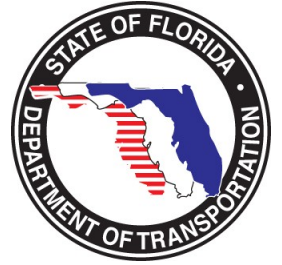

On Thursday, March 4, 2010, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a preconstruction **Public Information Meeting for the Little Lake Worth Bridge Replacement Project**, from 6 p.m. until 8 p.m., at the Hilton Singer Island Ocean Front, 3700 North Ocean Drive on Singer Island in the City of Riviera Beach. A brief presentation will be followed by an open question and answer period. Project personnel will be available to address attendee's questions and concerns.

Construction is scheduled to begin April 2010 between Portage Landing and Landing Place and last approximately one year. This project is being built in conjunction with the Little Blue Heron Bridge Replacement Project, which began construction in December 2009. The estimated combined cost for these projects is \$10.1 million and work is being performed by Murphy Construction Company.

Improvements Being Made:

The existing bridge will be replaced with a new two-lane fixed bridge in the same location. The new bridge will provide four additional feet of clearance (for a total of 12 feet) to meet current FDOT standards and minimize future damage to the bridge deck caused by salt water.

Traffic Impacts:

Work will be done in phases to minimize impacts to motorists, residents and businesses. Access to area businesses and residences will be maintained and one lane in each direction will remain open at all times.

Marine Traffic Impacts:

Recreational water sports will not be permitted in the work zone during construction.
