The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a Public Information Open House for the State Road (S.R.) 805 / S. Dixie Highway Resurfacing Project from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m., Wednesday, April 7, 2010, in the S. Dixie Highway Construction Field Office, 3720 S. Dixie Highway, Suite B, West Palm Beach. Project team members will be on hand to provide interested residents and business operators with information about this project, scheduled to begin April 12, 2010.

This one-mile resurfacing project goes from just north of S.R. 80 / Southern Boulevard to just north of Belvedere Road. The project will last approximately nine months, weather permitting, and cost an estimated \$1.1 million. Weekly Asphalt Paving, Inc. will be performing the work and AIM Engineering & Surveying, Inc. will be overseeing the contractor on behalf of FDOT.

Scope of Work:

- Repaving and restriping S. Dixie Highway from just north of Southern Boulevard to just south of Belvedere Road
- Minor traffic signal upgrades
- Minor storm water drainage improvements
- Replacing damaged curb and gutter, driveways and sidewalks at various locations in the project limits
- New pedestrian curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Upgrading street signs

Maintenance of Traffic:

In order to minimize impacts to residents, motorists and area businesses, work will be performed in phases. However, it will be necessary to close travel lanes, on-street parking and sidewalks to perform this work safely.

At least one lane will remain open in each direction through the work zone. Pedestrian traffic will be maintained on one side of the road at all times.

This project requires closing driveways and entrances for brief periods to accommodate construction. Project personnel will coordinate with property owners and businesses in advance of any closures to minimize impacts.
